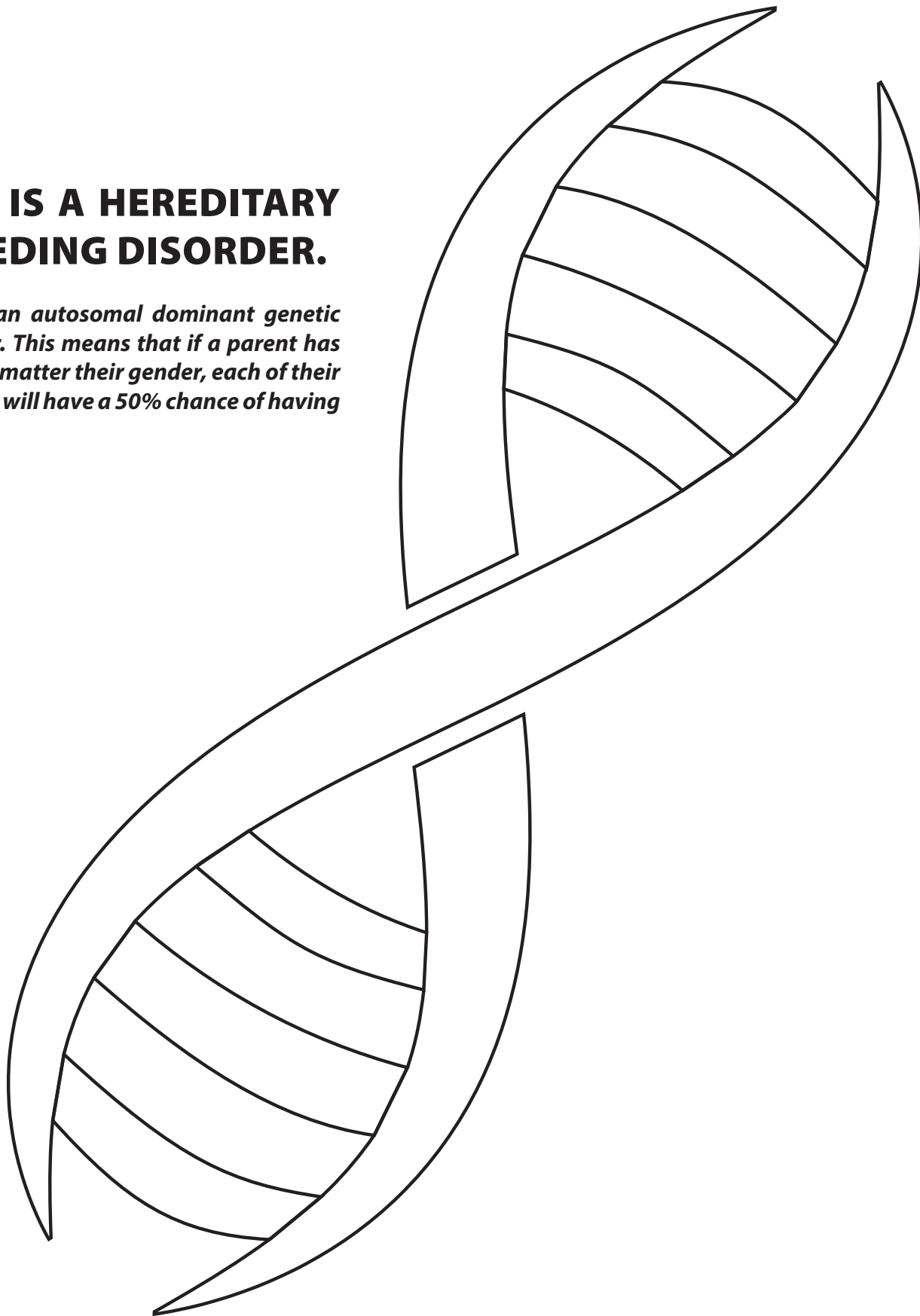


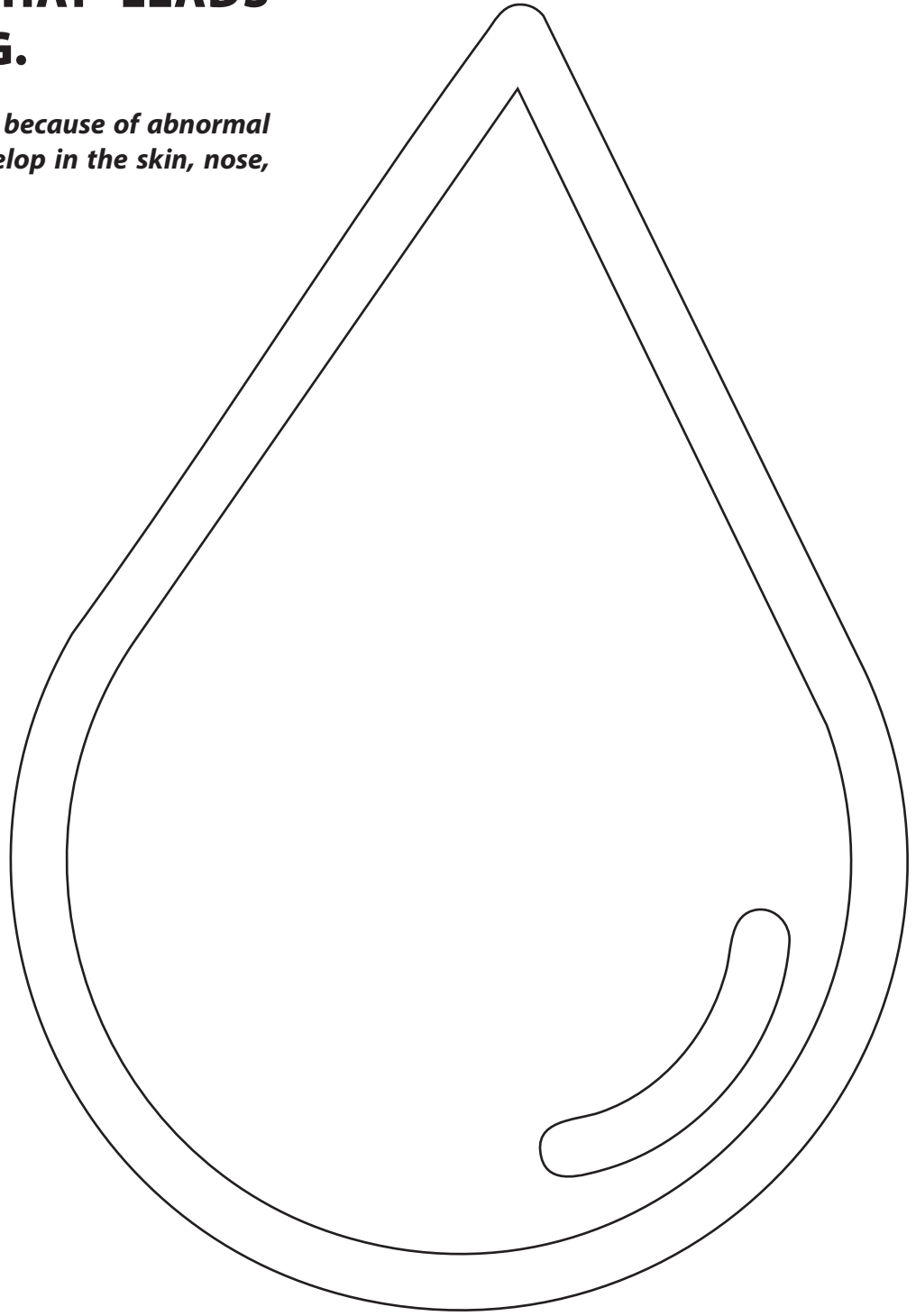
HHT IS A HEREDITARY BLEEDING DISORDER.

HHT is an autosomal dominant genetic disorder. This means that if a parent has HHT, no matter their gender, each of their children will have a 50% chance of having HHT.



HHT IS A BLOOD VESSEL DISORDER THAT LEADS TO BLEEDING.

People with HHT bleed because of abnormal blood vessels that develop in the skin, nose, GI tract, and elsewhere.



95% OF PEOPLE WITH HHT WILL DEVELOP SYMPTOMS OVER THEIR LIFETIME.

Once a diagnosis is made, a person with HHT can be properly screened and treated. This can help to avoid severe events due to HHT from occurring and allows HHT patients to live full lives without worrying about their disease.
